Skills First Training

This training is delivered with Victorian and Commonwealth Government Funding and is available to eligible individuals. Eligibility for the Skills First Program will be assessed by our Course Consultants (RTO Authorised Delegate Staff) prior to enrolment. Please note undertaking a government funded course may impact your access to further government funded training. Location of Training

All face to face training is delivered at Integrity Educations office, located at Level 4, 84 William Street, Melbourne, Vic 3000.

Skills First Tuition Fees

The student tuition fees as published are subject to change given individual circumstances at enrolment.

Concession Fees *

For enrolments in courses at the Certificate IV level and below, individuals are eligible for the concession fee (20% of the Standard Tuition Fee) if they, prior to the commencement of training, hold a current and valid:

- a) Health Care Card issued by the Commonwealth (Also applies to a dependent spouse or dependent child)
- b) or Pensioner Concession Card (Also applies to a dependent spouse or dependent child)
- c) or Veteran's Gold Card; or
- d) an alternative card or concession eligibility criterion approved by the Minister for the purposes of the Guidelines.

Payment Plans **

All workshop programs where the fee is over \$1,500 is payable by a payment plan. The first installment is \$1,500 and then the remaining fees are paid in up to 2 further installments, as agreed upon enrolment.

Indigenous Completions Initiative (ICI) ^

Individuals of Indigenous descent are eligible for the concession fee which equates to 20% of the Standard Tuition fee, irrespective of the level of the qualification.
